COVID in the IFC & PHC Community

Are there COVID cases within our community right now?

Reporting a positive case

1. Notify your chapter president

- a. Chapter House (Live-ins)
- b. Residence Hall (Live-outs)
- c. Off-Campus Residence (Live-outs)
- 2. President emails the CFSL
- 3. President will message the chapter about the chapter having a positive case and positive persons/close contact need to quarantine/isolate
- 4. President reaches out to Student Health about testing for the house
- 5. Answer the phone when Benton County Health case investigator

Social Gathering Limit

OSU Physical Distancing Policy

- 5.1.8 Student Social Get-Togethers
 - No more than 6 people indoor/outdoor

• State Guidelines

 No more than 6 people from 2 different households

Council Bylaws

- FSL Social Moratorium
- More than 3 people in one chapter becomes a chapter-related event
- Social Moratorium

Hold Members Accountable

Chapters

- Implement policies that hold members accountable for their actions around COVID
- Enforce your own policies
- Inform your chapter president

Oregon State University

- Submit incident report on SCCS
- Contact VP of Judicial Affairs for your council

Testing

- TRACE
- Rite-Aid in Corvallis
- NOVA Health offers rapid tests
 - Located in Eugene
 - Covered by insurance

Quarantine & Isolation

- Members who test positive need to isolate
- Members in the house need to quarantine
- Negative results do not release people from quarantine before the end of 14 days
- Remember to work with your chapter presidents
